The Life Cycle Association of New Zealand (LCANZ) is New Zealand's peak professional organisation for people involved in the use and development of Life Cycle Assessment (LCA).

LCANZ's mission is to provide a focal point for Life Cycle Assessment and Management work conducted in New Zealand. It's our aim to promote networking and knowledge sharing between organisations and people.

A not-for-profit organisation, LCANZ has individual and corporate members from industry, government, academia and service organisations. We welcome membership from people interested in the ethical practice, use, development and interpretation of LCA.

This code of conduct describes the attributes expected of members of LCANZ and as such compliance with this code of conduct is a condition of membership.

Personal Conduct

It is expected that LCANZ members will:

- act ethically, with honesty and integrity;
- contribute to LCANZ to create a safe and productive environment/culture;
- treat fellow members, colleagues, clients for LCA services and the public with respect, courtesy, honesty and fairness, and have proper regard for their interests, rights, safety and welfare;
- not harass, bully or discriminate fellow members, colleagues, clients for LCA services and the public;
- not make improper use of their membership or misrepresent their role in LCANZ to gain advantage for themselves or for any other person;
- not disclose confidential LCANZ information or documents acquired through their membership, other than as required by law or where agreed by LCANZ;
- not make any unauthorised public statements on behalf of LCANZ regarding the business of LCANZ; and
- act in the best interest support and promote the goals and interests of LCANZ.

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
